LOCATION: At Great River Road State Park, Rosedale, MS.

SIZE: 500 acres.

DEPTH: Varies with the Mississippi River.

AQUATIC VEGETATION: Duckweed.

MAJOR SPORTFISH: Largemouth bass, crappie, bream (bluegill), channel catfish.

OTHER FISH: Bowfin, buffalo, common carp, drum, flathead catfish, green sunfish, gar, white bass.

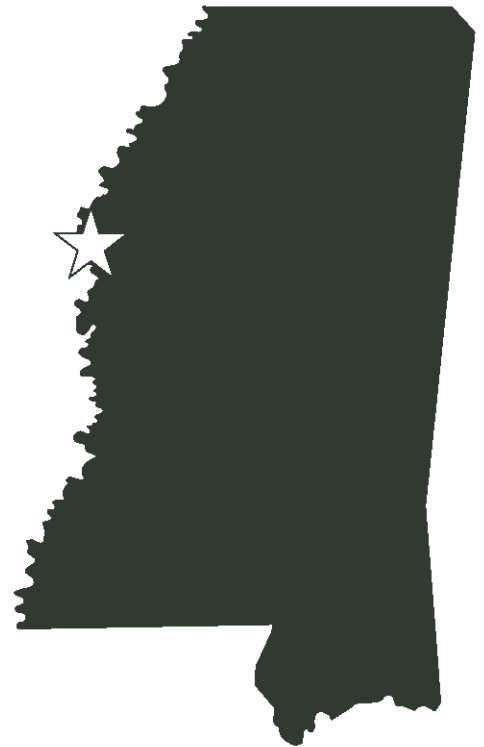
FISH FORAGE: Shad, silversides, minnows, sunfish.

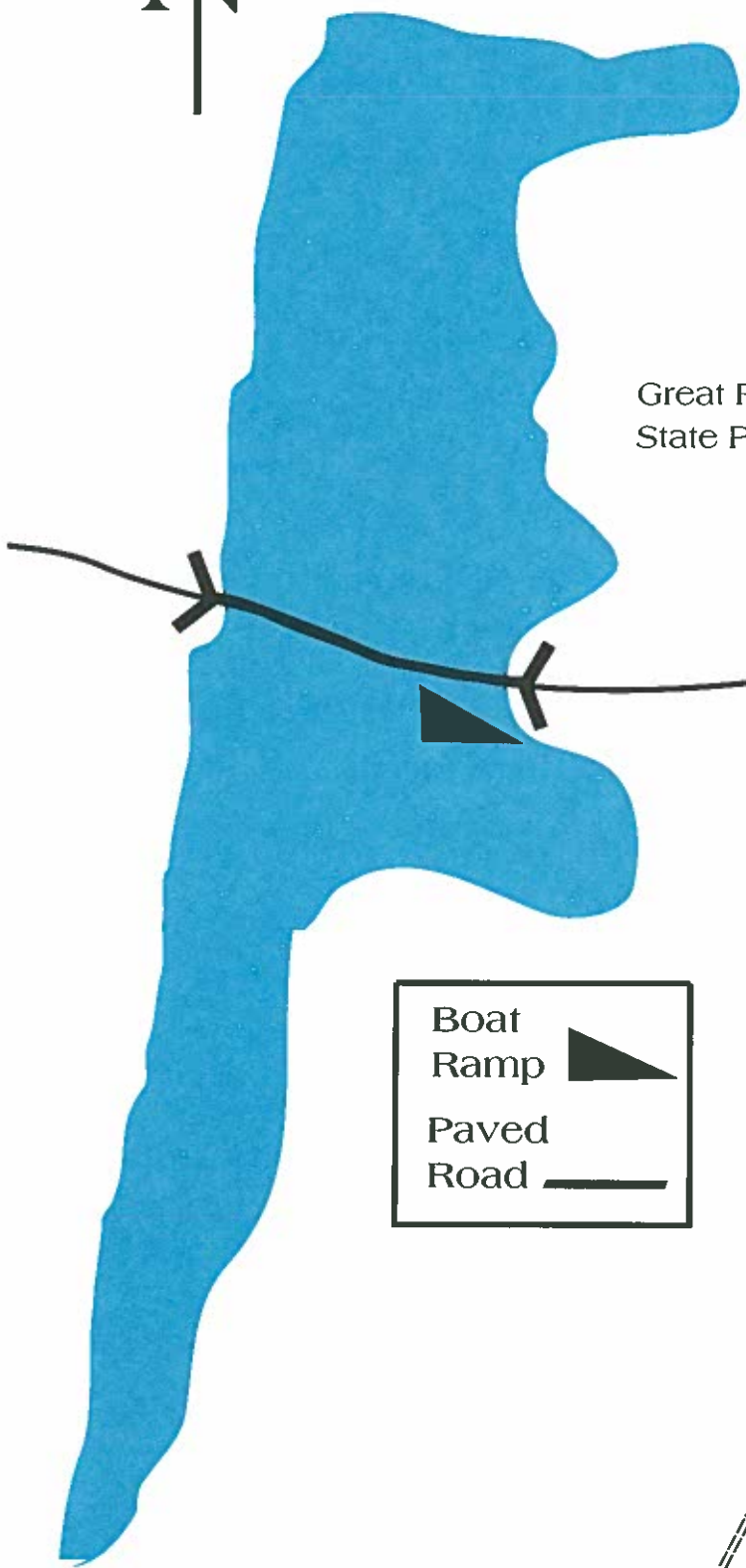
MAN-MADE FISH STRUCTURES: None

DESCRIPTION: The lake is an oxbow of the Mississippi River. It is fed by the river during periods of high water. During low water, the depth is six feet and less. The Great River Road State Park has rental boats as well as camp sites and trailer pads with electrical and water hook-ups. Playgrounds, hiking trails, a baseball/softball diamond, a river overlook tower and a visitors center with a restaurant are some of the other attractions of the park. Bait and tackle are available in Rosedale.
